#### **Laptops**

We are in the process of acquiring a limited number of laptops for our families who have difficulty accessing online learning due to lack of equipment. The laptops are the property of Park Lane Primary School and would remain with your family for an agreed period of time to ensure that your child can access their learning remotely through Zoom lessons and Seesaw activities that we are currently offering for our Griffins during this period of lockdown.

We have a limited supply and therefore we must allocate them on the basis of greatest need and will need to justify our allocations. It is pertinent that you provide us with enough information so that we can understand your need to help us your circumstances.

#### **Additional data**

The Government have issued a scheme providing free increases to mobile data to enable access to online learning for children who are studying at home. This is for those children who do not have fixed broadband at home and are struggling to afford additional data resulting in a disrupted to their education. The guidance states that the student must be in Year 3, 4, 5, or 6 and the following networks are participating in the scheme: EE, Three, Sky Mobile, SMARTY, Tesco Mobile, Virgin Mobile.

- The account holder's name (they must be over 18)
- The mobile number
- The name of the mobile network
- Whether the mobile is on a Pay-as-you Go basis or a monthly account.

## **Privacy statement**

1. For the purposes of data protection, I need to let you know that the Department for Education (DfE) is running the Mobile Network Offer through schools and their trusts or local authorities.
2. If the offer is taken up by an adult account holder, the school or social care team will share the account holder's name and mobile phone details with the DfE, who will share these with the relevant mobile network operator.
3. The mobile network operator will use that information to increase the data available for the account holder's mobile device, as long as they qualify for the offer.
4. The adult account holder's personal data is only shared with their mobile network operator for the purposes of the offer. No names of children or other adults, other than the adult account holder, are shared with the DfE or the mobile network operator.
5. No personal information will be shared with the DfE if you do not want to take up the offer.
6. If you want to know more about how your personal information will be used before you take up the offer, we can send that to you first.
7. If you decide to take up the offer, you'll get a text message from the Department for Education with more information about your data protection rights.
