Re: Lockdown Organisation

Dear Park Lane Families,

We must begin with expressing our appreciation for the positive response from our Park Lane Community to the most recent announcements. The lockdown has happened with immediate effect and today has meant various organisational procedures have had to be implemented to ensure for effective, yet manageable provisions to be offered. We thank you for your patience whilst we have adapted to our remote learning provision.

Key Worker/Vulnerable Children Provision

We have spent the day communicating with our Families to prioritise our key worker and vulnerable children to ensure for a consistent and substantial provision. You will have been contacted today to invite your child into school tomorrow/this week to continue with their learning. Our one-way system will be in operation for our key worker and vulnerable children and their provision will begin at 9:00 and finish at 3:00. Our gates will open at 8:45 to welcome these children into school and will close at 8:55. At the end of the day, our gates will reopen at 3:00 and close at 3:10. It is an expectation that our Griffins who are coming into school will be expected in full school uniform. PE days will remain for our Griffins in school and are able to come into school wearing their PE kits, as normal. We are unable to offer our wraparound care provision during the lockdown period. We thank you, in advance, for your understanding with this matter. Our key worker and vulnerable children who are attending school will need to bring their packed lunch in a disposable bag.

Remote Learning Expectations

Our platform Seesaw has been hugely successful throughout this past year and has provided an accessible, consistent approach to learning for our Griffins. We will be continuing to utilise Seesaw throughout the following six weeks. Alongside our Seesaw platform, we are thrilled to be able to offer live learning for our Griffins. The live learning sessions will be accessible via links that will be uploaded to your children's Seesaw accounts. To ensure that all Griffins are able to access the live learning, we have tried to stagger the Zoom learning. Home learning portfolios will be uploaded to Seesaw in due course with relevant activities relating to your child's Foundation learning.

FSM/Pupil Premium Children

Until further guidance is released, those children who are eligible for free school meals, and are in school, will receive a school dinner. For those children who are currently remote learning, packed lunches will be available to collect from the outside of the school entrance between 12:00-12:30. As always, we will continue to keep you updated on further information regarding the voucher scheme that we hope to implement again.

We will, as always, keep in close communication with you if there are any further developments. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any concerns: although our doors may be closed to most Griffins in a physical sense, our dedication and vocation to our Family remains.
