Re: Lockdown Announcement

Dear Park Lane Families,

It is with great sadness that we write to you this evening following the Prime Minister's announcement declaring that all Primary Schools across England will be closed until further notice. Following this announcement, the doors of Park Lane will be closed to all Griffins except those that are identified as being key worker children and those identified as being vulnerable children.

As you can imagine, this announcement has meant that certain organisational structures need to be firmly implemented to ensure that effective, yet manageable provision can be provided. This does mean that on Tuesday 5th January, we will be holding a 'Reset Day' to prepare for remote learning to begin on Wednesday 6th January. Therefore, the school will remain closed tomorrow to all Griffins, however your children's class teachers will be accessible via our Seesaw platform, providing remote learning for our Griffins and to allow for consistency during this difficult, unchartered time. From Wednesday 6th January, zoom lessons will commence where our Griffins will be able to actively engage in live learning with their peers followed by work via Seesaw to consolidate their learning.

In order to support us with our organisation, can we ask that you advise the school, via the school's admin account on admin2636@welearn365.com, by midday tomorrow, if you are a key worker to ensure that the correct provisions are put in place for your children. Those children that are identified as vulnerable children/key worker children will be notified tomorrow and invited into school on Wednesday 6th January.

We must take this opportunity to express our sincerest of appreciation to our Park Lane Community for the way that they have responded to the ever-changing, unprecedented climate that we are currently experiencing. It is a challenging time for all, and whilst this evening's announcement will have been rather difficult to digest, we will continue to work closely as one family and will be together again soon. We will, as always, keep in close communication with you if there are any further developments. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any concerns: although our doors may be closed to most Griffins in a physical sense, our dedication and vocation to our Family remains.
